Horse Achievement Awards

AHA's premier recognition program for horses that actively compete. This program honors your horse by adding symbols of prestige to his name. Work at your own pace as you aspire to the top of six levels of achievement. Horses earn points for competing and placing in AHA-recognized events, including breeding/In-hand classes, performance classes, competitive trail rides, eventing, Arabian racing, dressage, gymkhana, and endurance rides.

Horses enrolled in the Achievement Awards Program are eligible for the year-end High Point Achievement Award. The year-end prize is awarded to the Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian horse that's earned the highest number of Achievement Award points from Jan 1 through Dec 31. The High Point Achievement Award horse will be featured in the *Modern Arabian Horse* magazine.

Distance Horse Program

Provides recognition for horses that reach mileage goals in Endurance and/or Competitive Trail. Awards begin at 500 miles, at which time AHA gives out a perpetual plaque engraved with the horse's name and registration number. Owners receive a brass mileage marker for each additional 500 miles reached.

Open Qualifying Programs

AHA Cutting/Working Cow/Reining/Reined Cow Horse: Allows for scores earned at NCHA/ACHA/NRCHA/NRHA open competitions to count towards AHA Regional and National Qualifications.

AHA Dressage: Allows scores earned at USEF/EC open competitions not recognized by AHA to count towards AHA Regional and National Qualifications.

AHA Eventing/Combined Driving/Carriage Pleasure Driving/Driven Dressage: Allows placings and/or points from USEF/EC/ADS open competitions not recognized by AHA to count towards AHA Regional and National Qualifications.

AHA Working Hunter/Jumper/Hunter Hack: Allows placings and/or points from USEF/EC open competitions not recognized by AHA to count towards AHA Regional and National Qualifications.

USDF All-Breeds Award

Allows eligibility for year-end awards with the United States Dressage Federation (USDF) in the Open, Adult Amateur, Junior/Young Rider and Vintage Cup divisions for both Arabians and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabians for Training through Grand Prix Levels. Top 5 horses receive certificates and Champions receive an exclusive additional prize.

Breeders Sweepstakes - Deferred Billing available for this program only

Nominated Sires: All foals by a Nominated Sire are eligible to become Breeding Entries. Nominated Sires also earn 5% of all their Breeding Entry progeny's allocated and points prize money. Entries must be made by December 31 or late fees may apply.

Nominated Dams: Allows foals out of Purebred Mares, bred to non-Arabian stallions to become eligible Half-Arabian Breeding Entries. Entries must be made by December 31 or late fees may apply.

Anglo-Arabian Nominated Dams: Allows foals out of Anglo-Arabian mares to be eligible as Breeding Entries. Resulting foals must meet registration requirements of 25% to 75% Arabian blood.

Original Entries: Earn Sweepstakes Allocated and Points Prize Money even if your horse missed out on being entered as a Breeding Entry.

Sweepstakes Points Enrollment: (Not eligible for Deferred Billing) This is an optional program. Annual enrollment allows Breeding and Original entries to earn pay back through the accumulation of points in Sweepstakes points designated events when eligible throughout the enrolled year. Enrollments must be made on-line or postmarked or electronic transaction dated to the AHA office before the first day of the show/event. Any points won before the payment of the \$100 enrollment fee will not be paid. Annual enrollment fees are non transferable and non refundable.
