 26 Resolved, That USEF AR245 be amended by inserting a new paragraph 3 as follows:

 28 3. ***A rider that is off pattern will be disqualified and receive a zero score for both the reined work and the equitation***
 29 ***score. A disqualified rider with a zero score will not receive any award except in a work off, in the case of a tie, the***
 30 ***rider will be placed last of those chosen for a work off. In a multiple go class, a rider receiving a zero in the first go***
 31 ***may move forward to the second go round. A rider receiving a zero in the second or subsequent go round is eligible to***
 32 ***receive a placing/prize provided they received a score other than zero in one of the previous go rounds.***; and, Be It
