49 Whenever legal title to a registered horse passes to another by reason of death of the recorded owner, by 50 reason of foreclosure of any lien or by any order or decree of court, or otherwise by operation of law, the 51 AHA Registry may transfer the registration of such horse to the new owner: 52 1. Upon order of a court of competent jurisdiction or other satisfactory proof of authority for the transfer; 53 2. Upon payment of the transfer fee and any reasonable costs and expenses of investigation; and 54 3. - a. A good faith purchase may be shown through a bill of sale that is not contested by the recorded full registration owner within sixty days of notice being delivered to the last known address of the last recorded owner. Such notice shall be issued by AHA through both email and certified mail, return receipt, if requested by the person claiming ownership of the horse following DNA testing, and such person has paid to AHA the then established postal service rates for certified mail return receipt delivery of such notice. If the horse is acquired from a licensed rescue or 501(c)(3) organization in compliance with applicable law, only email notice is required. The sole bases for the recorded full registration owner to contest the issuance of a COMPETITION ELIGIBLE HORSE CERTIFICATE are that (i) the recorded full registration owner sold the horse to the person requesting the COMPETITION ELIGIBLE HORSE CERTIFICATE or a member of their immediate family and/or a business entity in which they have an ownership interest or vice versa, and payment or part of the payment is still owed to the recorded full registration owner; or (ii) a court has determined that the applicant was not a bona fide purchaser and/or the applicant receiving a COMPETITION ELIGIBLE CERTIFICATE for the horse would violate the lawful rights of the recorded full registration owner. In this regard, the Association will recognize any distinction a court or the involved parties would make, in regard to the activities the COMPETITION ELIGIBLE CERTIFICATE horse could engage in; so that if, for example, the horse was only to be prohibited from being shown, it might still receive a COMPETITION ELIGIBLE CERTIFICATE to qualify to compete in distance rides and/or the recreational riding program, etc. .
