<u>ENTRY REQUIREMENT</u>	<p>Foal is enrolled in-utero. Entry requirements must be met in order for the foal to be eligible to be enrolled by December 31 of the year the mare is bred.</p> <p>Late enrollment is allowed – see late fees.</p>	<p>Breeder/Nominator refers to the person(s) or entity who nominated the Breeding Entry. The Breeder/Nominator cannot be transferred.</p>	<p>Foal is enrolled in-utero. Entry must be submitted by December 31 of the year the mare is bred. Renominations must be paid for the weanling, yearling and 2-year-old year in order for the foal to be eligible to be shown at US Nationals. <u>PRIZE MONEY POOL</u>	<p>Sweepstakes prize money at the Regional and National Level are paid through the Sweepstakes Principal Fund. This is compiled of enrollment fees into the Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes Program.</p>	<p>Breeder/Nominator Payback is paid through the Sweepstakes Principal Fund. This is compiled of enrollment fees into the Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes Program.</p>	<p>Purebred initial nomination fee will be divided equally between the filly, colt and gelding classes. HA/AA initial nomination fee will be divided equally between the filly and gelding classes. Subsequent renomination fees will go into the jackpot by gender that the nominee will show in. A \$100 show entry fee will also be made for the show holding the class.</p>	<p>The enrollment fee if paid in full on or before June 1 of the year the horse is going to be shown is \$745. The \$700 goes into the prize money pool for the classes-entered. The \$45 processing fee is retained by AHA.</p>

<u>HOW MONEY IS AWARDED</u>	<p>Payout issued by the 50% Rule Exceptions: National Yearling Classes, ABS AAOTR Jackpot Classes, ABS AAO Performance Halter Classes, ABS Sport Horse Under Saddle AO Jackpot, ABS Green Working Hunter and the ABS Dressage Prospect Incentive Class. Checks for prize money shall be mailed no later than 60 days upon receipt of complete results.</p>	<p>The original nominator of the Breeding Entry shall be awarded a payback equal to 15% of the Prize Money awarded to that entry at National and Regional Events provided all Sweepstakes requirements have been met. The recorded owner must have a current membership as of December 31 to receive Breeder/Nominator payback. This prize money is issued in February of the following year.</p>	<p>Payout is issued to a full Top Ten.
