Competitors will compete for top honors in over 20 disciplines, including Country English Pleasure, Reining, Hunter Pleasure, and Driving. Best of all, admission is free for the entire event, making it a great experience for the whole family to enjoy world-class Arabian horse competition.

This year, attendees can enjoy free T.A.I.L. (Total Arabian Interaction and Learning) tours, which will take place throughout the show, giving the public a behind-the-scenes look at a national horse show. Participants will have the opportunity to tour the barns, meet Arabian horses, and learn about the care and dedication that go into preparing for competition.

In addition to the tours, the event will feature over 30 vendors at the Exchange Center, offering everything from equestrian gear to unique gifts. Visitors can also look forward to a free Exhibitor Party on October 17th at 6:30 p.m., where food, drinks, and a chance to meet competitors will kick off the festivities.

Youth will take center stage during the Youth Judging and Hippology Contest, where teams from across the U.S. will compete in judging classes and test their equine knowledge. This event highlights the importance of youth engagement in the Arabian horse community.
