Bruce has had success as a trainer, instructor, breeder, and manager of some of our breed's top horses and breeding programs. He spent the last 25 years of his career working in Saudi Arabia. He was first recruited by Dirab Arabian Horse Center, the

Government Arabian Horse Authority and Registry, as head trainer and stud manager.

There Bruce and his wife Karin organized the first Arabian horse shows in the Kingdom.

In 2008 he went to work for Al Mohamadia Stud to establish and develop a world class Arabian horse

operation for HH Prince Abdullah bin Fahad Al Saud, They bred and produced many World, European, and US National Champions over the years.

Bruce received his Arabian judges card in 1976 and is the only American to hold a European, ECAHO, judges card which he maintained for 29 years.

He has judged more Arabian horses in various divisions, systems and countries than most anyone in the world over the past 50 years.

Bruce has judged most major shows in America, most every Regional at least once, US

Nationals 6 times, Canadian Nationals 3 times and Scottsdale show 9 times. He has judged Arabian horse shows on 6 continents, recently in China. In Europe he has judged the National Championship shows of 12 different countries, several of those multiple times. He has also judged the National Championship show of



Brazil, Ecuador, South Africa, Namibia, Israel, Qatar, Kuwait, United Arab Emirates, Bahrain, Saudi Arabia, Oman and Egypt. Most of those were multiple times as well.

Bruce and his family are very honored and humbled that he is receiving this prestigious Hall of Fame induction!
