- GR147.1 To be shown and judged in any class in which horses compete together, an animal must perform at all required gaits both ways of the ring in the original workout and must remain in the ring until excused by the judge.

Procedure:

1. This card is to be used in a situation where the judge is required to excuse, disqualify or eliminate a horse. Use of the card is not necessary in a scored class that already records a “no score” or elimination.
2. Make a note on the official judge’s card that a certain entry number is being disqualified or was eliminated.
3. Complete all fields of the “Red Card” and sign your name.
4. Submit the card along with the official judge’s card, if possible. If it is not possible to include with the card at the time, please deliver to the show secretary at the earliest possible time.
5. The exhibitor will be notified that the class will NOT count towards participation credit.
