- 19 Whereas,                      In the modern Hunter classes, there is a desire by competitors to distinguish themselves in competition,  
20 while retaining the conservative traditions of Hunters, and

- 22 Whereas,                      In the opinion of the proponent, it is believed that adding the color burgundy to the list of acceptable  
23 conservative colors will not only contribute to the beauty and tradition of the Hunter Pleasure and Hunter  
24 Under Saddle Divisions but also be of help to judges when distinguishing between individual competitors  
25 in a class, and

- 27 Whereas,                      The color burgundy has already been approved for the Hunter/Jumper division by USEF and it is believed  
28 it will also be a smart addition to our current list of acceptable colors.

30 Resolved,                      That USEF AR140.2.a be amended by inserting the words *or burgundy* in sub-paragraph a.:

- 32                      2. Attire:
- 33                      a. Informal attire is required. It includes a coat of conservative color (black, blue, gray, green, brown, or *burgundy*  
34 and conservative shades thereof) made of materials that are suitable for hunting. Discrete patterns such as tweeds,  
35 hounds tooth, jacquard, pinstripes or subtle plaids are allowed. Coats must be darker than the breeches or jodhpurs.  
36 Brocades, raised patterns, glossy/metallic/shiny fabrics or materials are not suitable for hunting. Ornamentation  
37 other than a stock or lapel pin, tie clip or tack, or monogram are not allowed on any item of attire. Gloves are  
38 optional, but if worn, must be of conservative color. Boots and conservatively colored hunting cap, derby, or  
39 protective headgear are mandatory. Nonconforming exhibitors must be severely penalized.
