Whereas, USEF AR293.3 is antiquated and no longer used with the scoring system, and

Whereas, The Education Evaluation Committee has been educating its judges on the proper use of the Score Card for the past five years, in addition the EEC supports the posting of the Showmanship Score Card; Therefore, Be It

Resolved, That USEF AR293. 3 be amended by striking out as follows:

~~3. Handlers may be asked to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion.; and, Be It~~

Resolved, That USEF AR296 Scoring, be amended by adding a new point 1. as follows:

1. Judges must use ~~and turn in~~ the prescribed Showmanship Score Card. At all multi judge shows, all multi judge Regional shows and all Nationals shows, score cards must be posted one hour after the completion of the session. It is mandatory at any show posting cards to have a designated walker and scribe.; and, Be It
