SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP PATTERN



Horses will enter the ring in back number order.

Judging begins when the horse enters the ring.

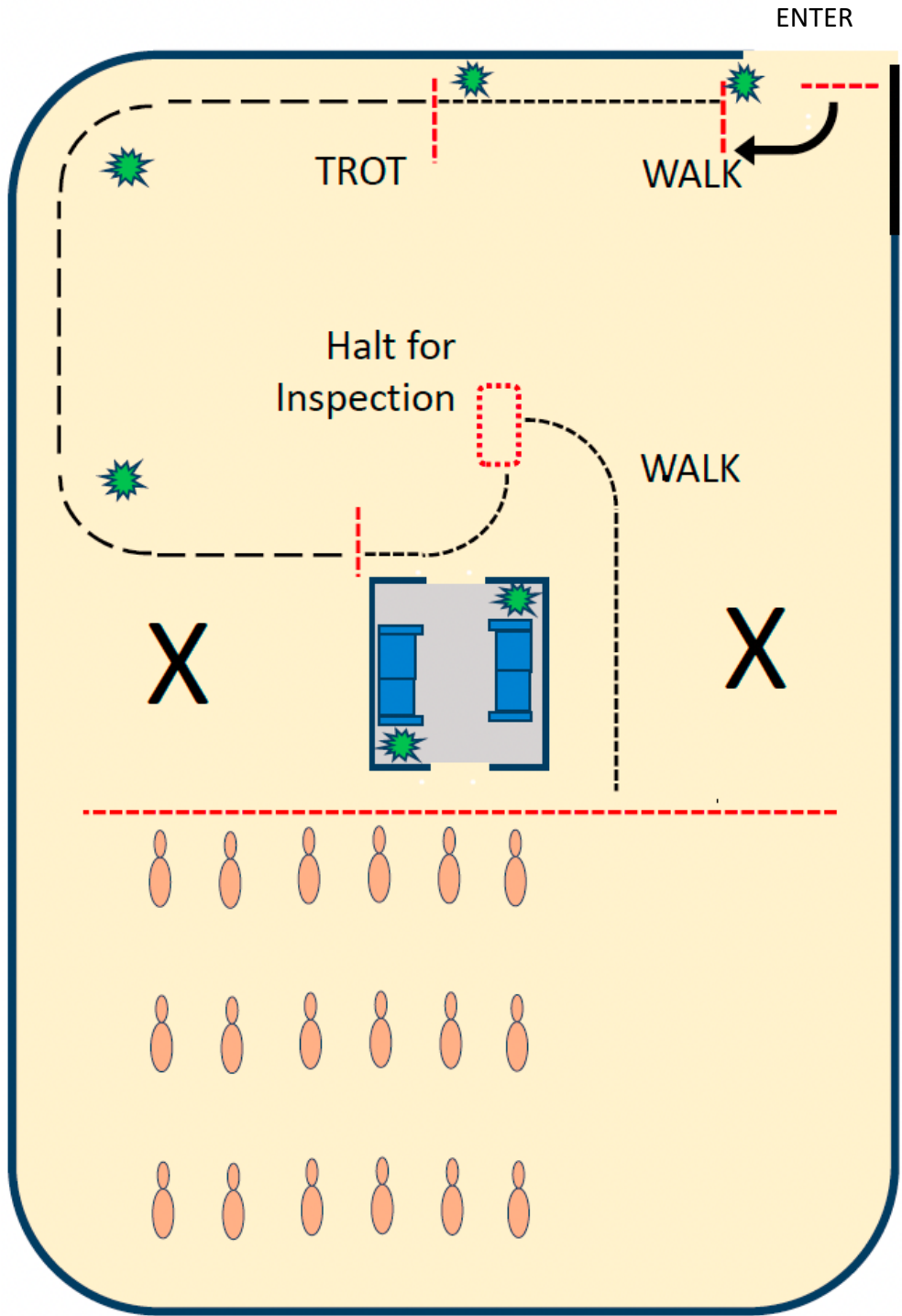
The horse will enter at a walk through what is commonly used as the Out-Gate to the first marker then pick up the trot.

At the second marker walk to judges. Halt for inspection.

In order to satisfy a proper presentation to the judges, horses should be shown in an "open position," with the horse's head and neck in a natural and comfortable carriage.

Following the evaluation by the judges, horses shall walk away from the judges to the line up.

The scorecards will be completed by the judges, turned in, and the next horse will enter the ring for evaluation.
