Execute a a large circle to the right on the right lead at the extended lope.


Execute a small circle to the right at the lope on the right lead.

Stop at marker D and execute a 180degree turn on the haunches to the left.

Extend the jog to marker B.


Stop at marker B and back to marker C.




Execute 270-degree turn to the right.
